- Talbott Vineyards Kali-Hart Pinot Noir, Monterey, California** \$49
Youthful and bright. Lush fruit and lively acidity. Signature floral aromas and cherry flavors.
- Domaine Lucien Boillot & Fils Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, Burgundy, France** \$75
Blend of fruit from Gevrey-Chambertin and Volnay. Structured, intense flavors and keen acidity.
- Bertani, Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy** \$33
Deep ruby red color with strong aromas of plum and cherry Light structure with elegant raspberry and spice flavors. Long and vibrant finish.
- Domaine Paul Autard, Cotes du Rhone, Rhone Valley, France** \$29
Aromas of licorice and spice. Raspberry and cherry flavors on the palate with a pepper finish.
- Columbia Winery Merlot, Columbia Valley, Washington** \$29
Dark and distinct color with aromas of cherry and plum, and a hint of violet. Pronounced notes of toasty oak, vanilla and mocha. Firm tannins and a lingering finish.
- Brancaia Ilatraia Super Tuscan, Tuscany, Italy** \$120
Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, cabernet franc. Rich and elegant. Dark fruits on the nose, firm tannins with a long finish.
- Chateau Vignot Bordeaux, Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France** \$80
Bright garnet color with a bouquet of red fruits and spices. Fresh raspberries and cherries on the palate with a long, round finish.
- Marchesi di Barolo, Barolo, Piedmont, Italy** \$95
Intense aromas of cinnamon, absinthe, and tobacco. The taste is full and elegant with soft tannins.
- Decoy Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, California** \$49
Enticing fruit-forward aromas of blackberry, currant and black cherry. The lush fruit is balanced by smooth, rich tannins and lovely layers of spice, cocoa and hints of sweet and toasty French oak.
- Cakebread Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** \$149
Scents of oak toast and dark chocolate, introduce layers of rich, deeply concentrated, yet elegant flavors of blackberry, boysenberry, fig, currant and fresh cherry. The wine's vibrant acidity, supple, seamlessly integrated tannins and impeccable balance contribute to a round long finish.
